The COVID-19 pandemic has made it clear that the health of an individual is the health of all, prompting the entire world to move increasingly towards a concept of collective and participatory health.

**Technological, telemedicine and e-Health tools have proved to be fundamental** for the creation of a global health network capable of responding in a timely manner to emergencies, enabling distances to be bridged, geographical obstacles to be overcome and to navigate towards a shared growth.

The Mediterranean can be thought of as an element of aggregation to expand the horizons of innovation towards new progress models.

The International Summit aims to spread knowledge on the topics of digital innovation in healthcare and to implement telemedicine services bordering the Mediterranean basin up to Middle East: an opportunity to meet and compare experiences, best practices and indications, identifying new tools and possibilities for the different socio-cultural context.

**MEDITEH BEYOND** was created to **facilitate meetings between Institutions** (Ministries, Embassies, National Bodies, Healthcare Authorities), **organizations in healthcare, scientific and technological research** (Research Institutes, Universities, Hospitals, Healthcare Services, etc.) and **companies involved in the technological sectors** from the Mediterranean, Africa and Middle East.
